Kristen Cook


(Composer) Since achieving a vocal degree from Berklee College of Music, Kristen has had 15 years of experience working in improv, voice over, theatre and as a recording artist.

Technical Requirements:

Performance space: In a dinner venue with a stage, works well with meal served or bar with drinks available. A stage area separated for performance area, with access to walk into the audience. Separate area backstage for a quick change needed.

Technician: Basic lights and sound tech, mostly cued from the performer.

Equipment needed:

- 3 Microphones, one wireless, preferably a headset.
- Keyboard, or piano is able to be mic'd.
- Music Stand.
- sound system to play tracks and live music.

Set: One high back chair, a chaise lounge, small antiquated side table.

Props: Various props, provided by production, to be set throughout the space.
